CROSSWORD PUZZLE

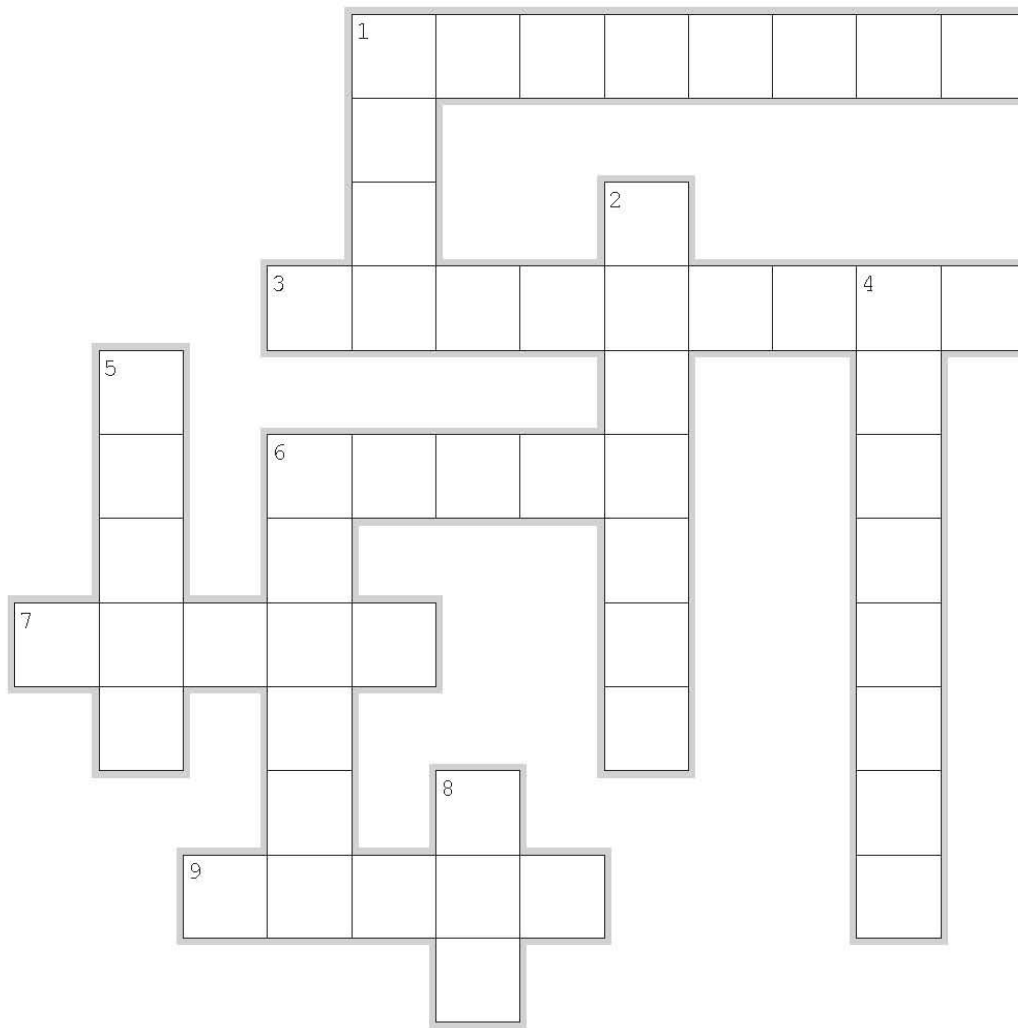
Deborah has submitted a model car crossword puzzle. It can be found in the attachment. Thank you Deborah.
